## Dunsmuir Sediment Placement Site

Los Angeles County Public Works manages a flood control system with dams, debris basins and other infrastructure throughout the County. During winter months, storms carry dirt and other organic material from undeveloped hillsides into our debris basins and reservoirs. Over the next several weeks, Public Works will transport rocks, dirt, and mud out of debris basins into the Dunsmuir Sediment Placement Site in Glendale and other locations.

### What to Expect

- Sediment hauling is scheduled throughout the current storm season.
- Work will take place Monday through Friday from 7a.m. to 5 p.m., with work on weekends limited to critical operations necessary to provide flood protection in the event of substantial storm events.

### Commitment to Community

- LA County Public Works will oversee the operation to ensure safety, efficiency, and cleanliness. Hauling activities will observe all traffic and safety laws.

### Parking

- Please do not park vehicles or store materials on streets near the sediment placement site. “No Parking” signage (if necessary) will be posted 48 hours in advance of maintenance activities.
